COMPLEMENTARY FEES – *ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE*

- **Complementary Services Fee:**
 - 60\$ per registration.
- **Evaluation Fee:**
 - 10\$ per evaluation.
- **Material Fee:**
 - 50\$ to 75\$ per session.
- **Popular Education*:**
 - 250\$ per session.
